Helpful Information about the FUMC Hurst Nursery


- The nursery is a safe and nurturing environment for your child and is located in the first hallway of the children's wing (closest to the Sanctuary).
- Pagers are provided to parents of infants/toddlers so you can be quickly and easily contacted if needed.
- All children/parents are given matching stickers to use at pick-up for security purposes.
- All nursery workers are CPR/First Aid certified and MinistrySafe approved.
- Consistent attendance helps infants/toddlers adjust to the routine of the nursery more quickly.
- Bring a diaper bag with diapers, wipes, bottles, sippy cup, full change of clothes, and a couple of comfort items (pacifier and/or blanket). Please be sure to label all items.
- All nursery and children's areas are peanut and tree nut free.

Helpful Tips for Parents

- A nursing mother's room is available in the nursery hallway in room C105. There are rocking chairs and changing tables available in that room. The worship services are live streamed into the nursing mother's room on Sunday mornings.
- Changing tables are located in the men's and women's restrooms near the Connect Desk/Foyer as well in the preschool hallway.
- If using a stroller on Sunday morning, consider parking on the north end of the building (to avoid the stairs near the Anderson Center entrance). Consider using Assisted Parking if you are traveling alone on a Sunday morning. Assisted Parking is located on the west side of the building at the circle drive.
- Infants and young children are always welcome to attend worship services with their families. If your child becomes restless and you feel you need to step out, you are welcome to participate via Livestream in the Foyer.



Ways to Support Your Infant/Toddler's Spiritual Development

- Read Bible stories to your child
- Sing songs to your child about Jesus (in the car, while feeding him/her, etc.)
- Bring your infant/toddler to church often so that he/she begins to build relationships with trusted adults in the church and in the church nursery
- Pray with your child often (before meals, at nap time, at bedtime, etc.)
